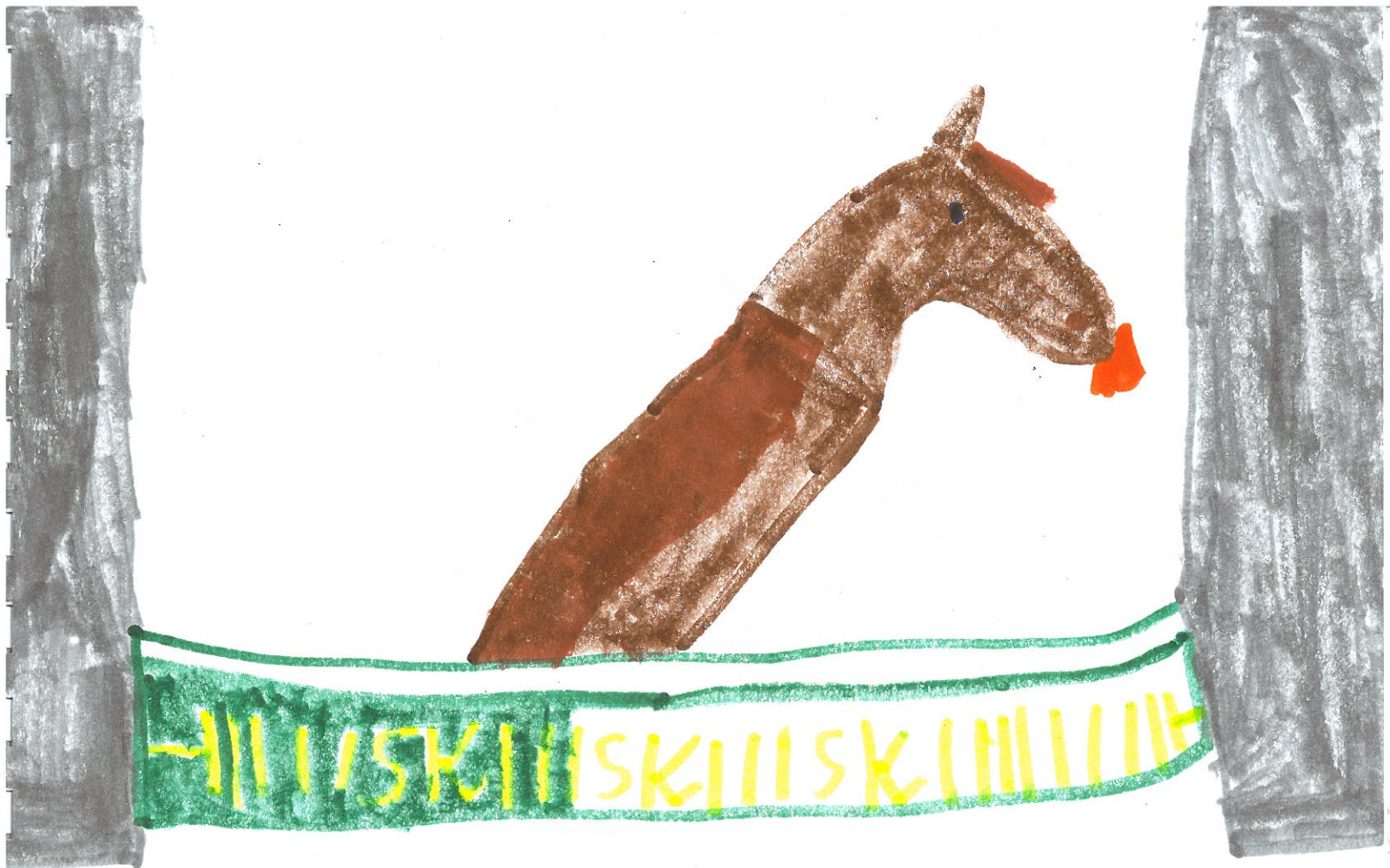


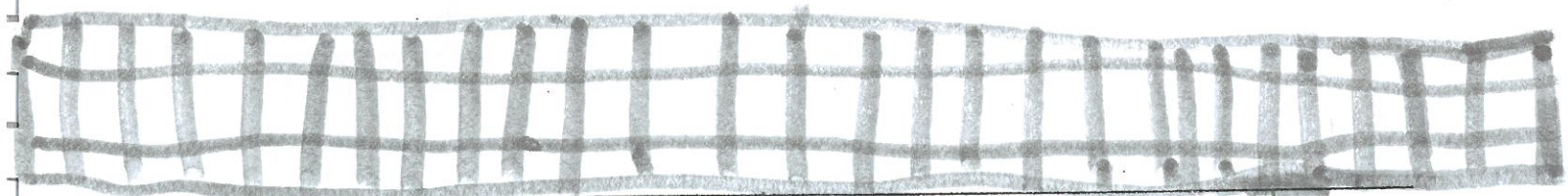
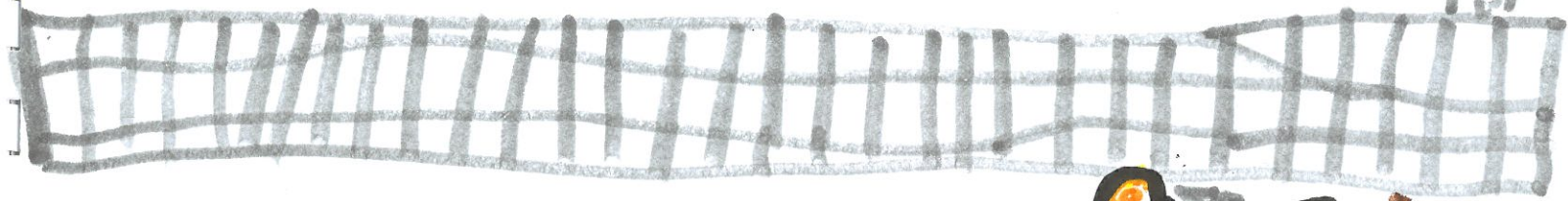
General Charley

Sometimes he comes in dead last.

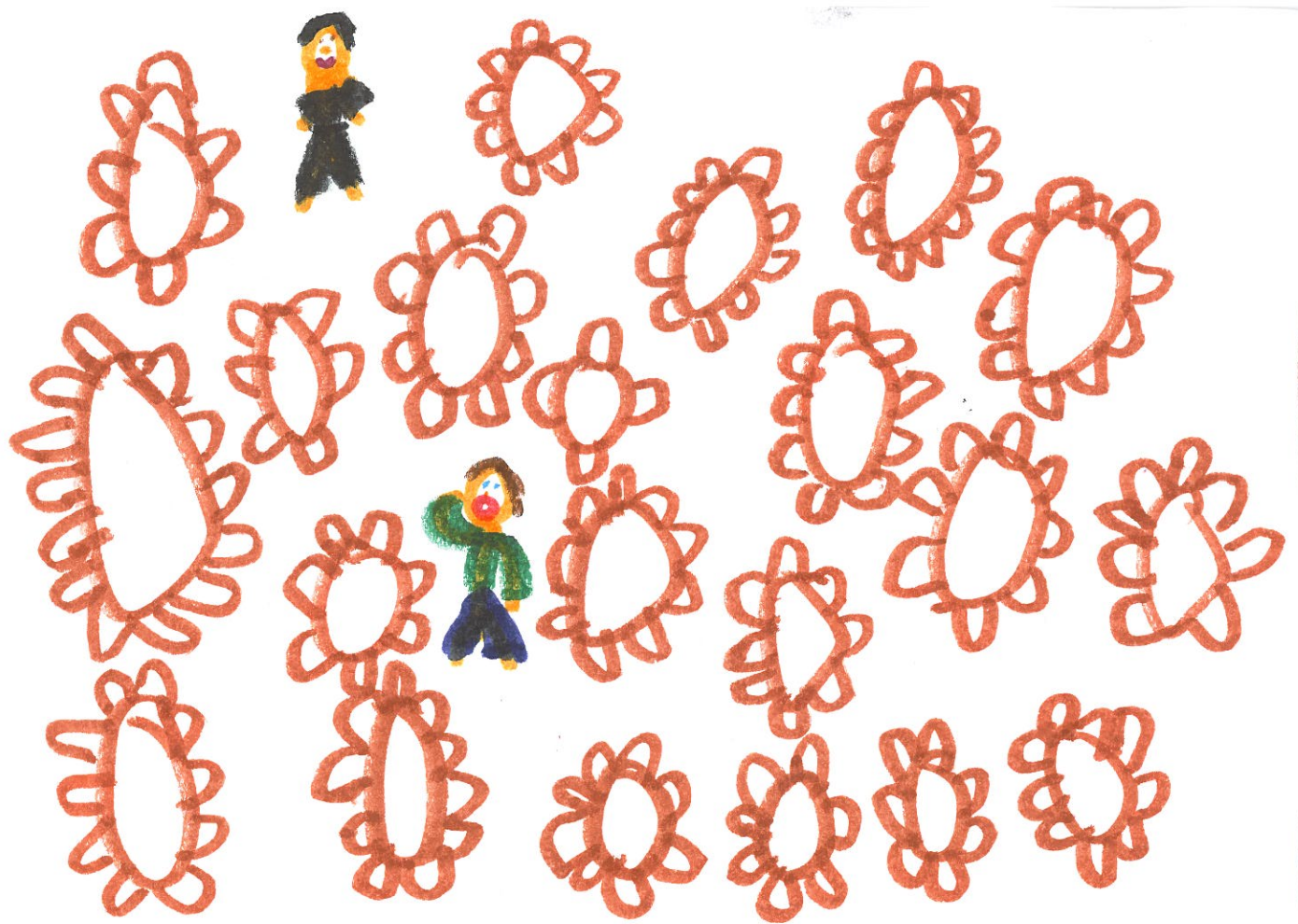
I hate it when that happens.

watches movies too.

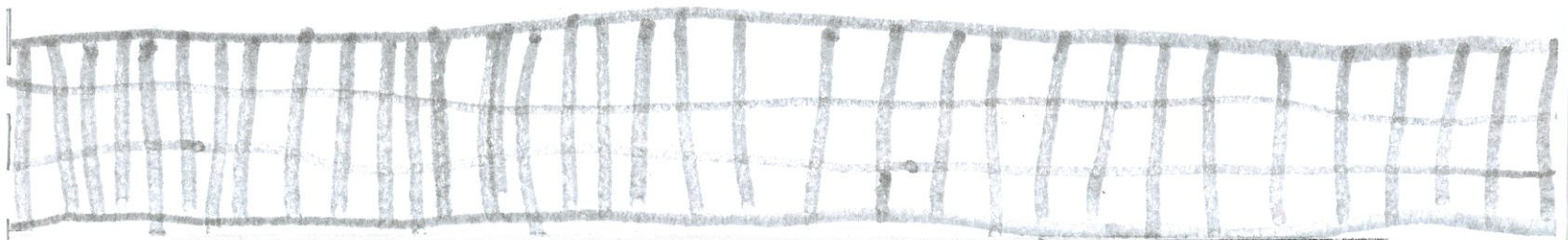
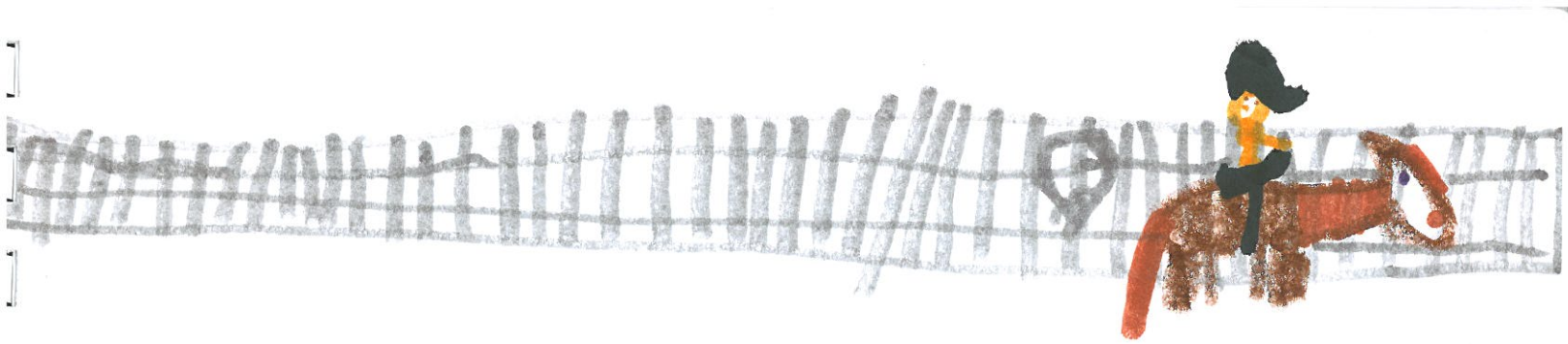


There is a certain place

Charley's trainer.

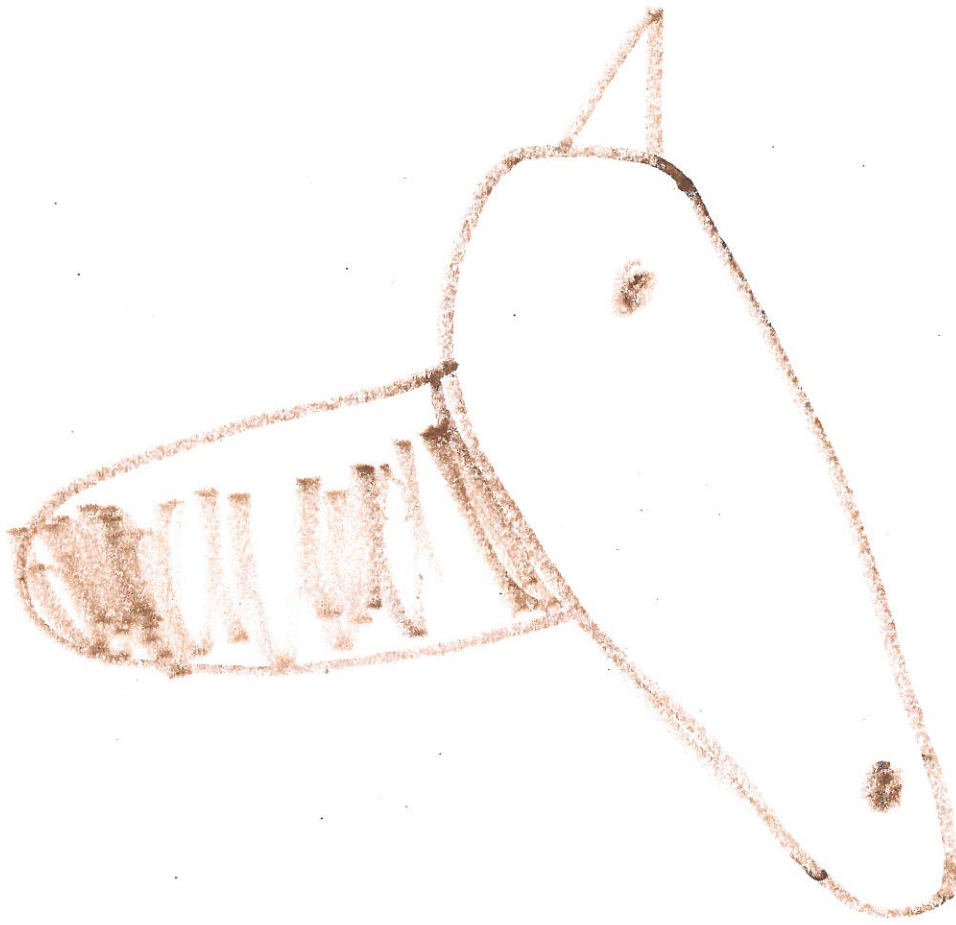


Charley always bolts out
